(1) Make different 5-digit number using flash cards and write the number name also. (Minimum 5- maximum 10)

(2) Make different 5-digit and 4-digit number using flash cards and arrange them in ascending and descending order. (minimum 5- maximum 10)

(3) Write the predecessor and the successor of 5-digit numbers. (any 10)

(4) Find the sum and the difference of the greatest and the smallest 5-digit numbers. (any 5)

Activity 2 : Make a colourful attractive pocket calendar for tables 2 to 12. Size 15 cm by 5cm. Spiral bind all the sheets. Learn the tables

Activity 3: Project:

IVA & IV B: Collect the age of any 10 relatives and present their age in the form of roman numerals on A3 size sheet and decorate it.

IV C & IV D: Make a landscape using 2 D and 3 D shapes on A3 size sheet and decorate it.

II. Paste picture of an animal and write its adaptations.
