


Goal – 7 Topic: Affordable And Clean Energy

1. Collect information on any one renewable source of energy and present it in the form of wall hanging.



<u>2.</u> Interview two neighbors to understand the different forms of energy used in their home and what measures do they take to save energy.

Some of the questions are here for your reference.

- What are the different forms of energy utilized in your home? Electricity/LPG/ CNG/Solar/ Petroleum/Others
- How do you go to nearby market? Walking/ Cycling/ By car/ Two wheelers/ any other
- Do you switch off the lights, fans and other electrical equipment when not in use? Yes/No
- Which form of energy is used in your home for cooking meals? Electricity/LPG/Solar/Others
- Do you think it is important to save energy? Yes/No
- How often do you reduce the energy you use for your home or vehicle for cost reasons ? always/often/ sometimes/or never
- How often do you reduce the energy you use for your home or vehicle for environmental reasons?always/often/ sometimes/or never
- Suggest any three ways in which you can help conserve energy.

After the interview prepare a survey report on A4 size sheet about consumption of different forms of energy, their benefits and drawback.
